COUNCIL REOPENING SOME FACILITIES

In line with directions from the NSW Government, Council will reopen the following facilities this Friday, 15 May:

- Passive parks
- Children's playgrounds
- Off-leash dog parks
- Public toilets
- Lawson Park will reopen to vehicles

Council will thoroughly clean each of these facilities prior to reopening and will continue a cleaning schedule, however residents should use these facilities with caution, use their own cleaning provisions where possible and wash hands immediately after use. Residents must continue to practise physical distancing and good hygiene. If you have even the mildest of symptoms, you should stay at home.

The reopening follows a return to regular services at Waste Facilities and Rural Waste Transfer Stations in recent weeks.

The following facilities are operating but remain closed to the public:

- Customer Service and Administration Centres: Closed in-person, available online and over the phone on 6378 2850. Council is working to reopen Customer Service Centres soon.
- Libraries: Closed in-person, delivery and pickup available. Contact 6378 2740.
- Community Transport: Limited service. Contact 6378 2710.
- Pound: Contact Council for more information.
- Mudgee Region Saleyards: Restricted access.

The following facilities remain closed:

- Mudgee Town Hall Cinema
- Community Halls and venues for hire
- Mudgee and Rylstone Showgrounds
- Ironed out and Tip Shops
