MUDGEE REGIONAL SALEYARDS





Mid-Western Regional Council (Council) is pleased to provide the opportunity for businesses, community groups and organisations to purchase advertising space at the Mudgee Regional Saleyards; a regional livestock auction facility for buyers and sellers.

LOCATION AND REGION

The Mudgee Regional Saleyards is located at 61 Abattoirs Road, just off the Castlereagh Highway at Menah, a seven minute drive from the Mudgee CBD. Mudgee is located in the Mid-Western Region which is within the Central Tablelands of NSW. The Mid-Western Region is prosperous and progressive, with a median house price of \$680,000 and Gross Regional Product of \$3.16 billion. The region has a 'Per Worker' Gross Regional Product of \$236,405 and a 'Per Hectare' Gross Regional Product of over \$3,616. One of the region's major industries is agriculture which has beef cattle and sheep farming businesses.

AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY AND BEEF/SHEEP SECTOR

The region's agriculture industry:

- → Contributes 5.5% (\$324 million) of the region's annual output
- → Contributes 4.1% (\$124 million) of the region's annual value add
- → Produces over \$59.4 million of annual sales
- → Produces \$257.4 million of regional exports annually
- → Produces \$84 million of local annual expenditure
- → Produces a productivity rate of \$137,000 per worker

The sheep, grains, beef and dairy cattle sectors contribute 696 jobs (6.9%) to total employment in the region.

OVERVIEW OF MUDGEE REGIONAL SALEYARDS

The Mudgee Regional Saleyards has been operating at it's current undercover site after moving in 1994. The Saleyards is owned, managed and maintained by Council who employs a dedicated Saleyards Supervisor to look after the facility. Council is committed to the livestock industry, animal welfare, a safe working environment, and improved efficiency and capacity at the Mudgee Regional Saleyards.

Multiple stock and station agents operate at Mudgee Regional Saleyards. The sale days are supported by meat companies, butchers, farmers and feedlot operators.



SALE DAYS

Sale days are held each Wednesday commencing at 8.30am for cattle and 11.30am for sheep. Sale of stock through store sales occurs on the last Thursday of every month, commencing at 11am. The sale days attract many agents, farmers and members of the general public. A number of special sales are also held throughout the year.

SERVICES AND FEATURES

The Mudgee Regional Saleyards provide the following services:

- → Sale of stock
- → Canteen facilities on sale days
- → Private kill sales
- → Avdata key operated truck wash facility
- Stock impounding
- → Stock stopovers for long haul carriers

Council built the saleyards facility in 2003 and has been committed to its maintenance and upgrades since. The undercover facility features:

- → Administration building/office space
- → Covered stock (cattle) sale pavilion with pens
- → Lamb sale pens

- → Stock holding/resting pens
- → Soft floors for stock comfort
- → Amphitheatre with a capacity of 55 people
- → Canteen facility
- → Cattle scale
- Elevated seating
- → Large sealed truck and public parking areas
- → Great views over the Cudgegong Valley
- Truck wash facilities

THROUGHPUT

This highly successful facility is one of the largest livestock exchange facilities in New South Wales, and achieves an annual throughput of approximately 20,000 cattle and 8,000 sheep and lamb sales, per year.

MARKETING ACTIVITIES

To grow the Saleyards capacity and increase the amount of stock sales, Council is committed to delivering effective marketing initiatives which will focus on advertising, media announcements, direct marketing, and community relations.

The revenue raised from selling advertising space at the facility will be directly used to fund ongoing marketing initiatives to effectively promote the Mudgee Regional Saleyards.

THE **OPPORTUNITY**

Council is seeking Expressions of Interest from interested businesses, community groups and organisations to enter in to a sponsorship agreement to purchase advertising signage space at the Mudgee Regional Saleyards for a minimum period of three years. The venue is a premium sale facility in the Mid-Western Region LGA.



- → Signage production and installation is to be arranged and paid for by each business, group or organisation. Council can provide signage specifications and details of preferred suppliers on request. All contractors must meet Council's Work Health and Safety requirements
- → Advertising of alcohol, tobacco or gambling will not be permitted
- → Council reserves the right to review and approve artwork prior to signage manufacture and installation
- → Minimum one year commitment
- → Applications to advertise products or services that are in direct competition with the facility or deemed generally inappropriate will not be accepted at the sole discretion of the Business Development Coordinator
- → Positioning of signs will be on a 'first in' basis
- → Signage fees outlined in this prospectus are for a 12 month period from the installation date of the sign, at which point a new invoice will be issued. Should payment not be received within 14 days, Council has the right to remove the sign and sell the advertising space. Please note signs will remain the property of the business, group or organisation
- → Signs must at all times remain visually appealing and safe. Signage maintenance is the responsibility of the business, group or organisation and must be addressed in a timely manner if and when directed by Council's Business Development Coordinator
- → Council does not accept liability for damage to any advertising signage, however, the Mudgee Regional Saleyards does have surveillance security systems in place



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
