

9.3 Naming of a new road in a subdivision off Wilbetree Road, Menah

RECOMMENDATION

That Council:

1. **receive the report by the Property Support Officer on the naming of a new road in a subdivision off Wilbetree Road, Menah; and**
2. **formally approve the name of Sallarges Lane.**

Executive summary

Formal approval is requested to name the new road in a subdivision off Wilbetree Road in the locality of Menah, Sallarges Lane.

Disclosure of Interest

Detailed report

Council, being the Roads Authority, is required to name new and unnamed streets and roads.

Following the approval of a new subdivision off Wilbetree Road in the locality of Menah, Council wrote to the neighbours of the subdivision on 21st July 2021 requesting their naming suggestions. Public consultation was also invited in an advertisement placed in the 23rd July 2021 Mudgee Guardian and on Council's website.

From submissions received, Council provisionally approved the name of Sallarges Lane at their 22nd September 2021 meeting.

- Sallarges relates to a nearby waterway called Sallarges Creek.

The Geographical Names Board has been advised of this road name and has no objection.

The new road name was advertised in the 8th October 2021 issue of the Mudgee Guardian and on Council's website with no additional submissions or objections received.

Notices of the new road name was served on Australia Post, the Registrar General, the Surveyor General, the NSW Ambulance Service, NSW Fire & Rescue, NSW Rural Fire Brigades, NSW Police Force, NSW State Emergency Service and NSW Volunteer Rescue Association via the NSW Online Place and Road Naming Proposal System with no objections received.

Street naming is legislated under the Roads Act (1993). This Act empowers the authority in charge of the road with the rights to name it. The naming of this road will allow the completion of street addressing within the new subdivision. Section 162 of the Roads Act (1993) states that "a road authority may name and number all public roads for which it is the authority. A road authority may not alter the name of a public road unless it has given the Geographical Names Board (GNB) at least two months' notice of the proposed name."

In accordance with Council's Road, Bridge & Place Naming Policy, should Council formally endorse the naming of this new road, notice of the approved name will be:

1. Published in the Government Gazette, the Mudgee Guardian and on Council's website.
2. Concurrently, notice of the new name will be sent to Australia Post, the Registrar General, the Surveyor General, the NSW Ambulance Service, NSW Fire & Rescue, NSW Rural Fire Brigades, NSW Police Force, NSW State Emergency Service and NSW Volunteer Rescue Association, and, in the case of a classified road – Transport for NSW.

'Sallarges Lane'

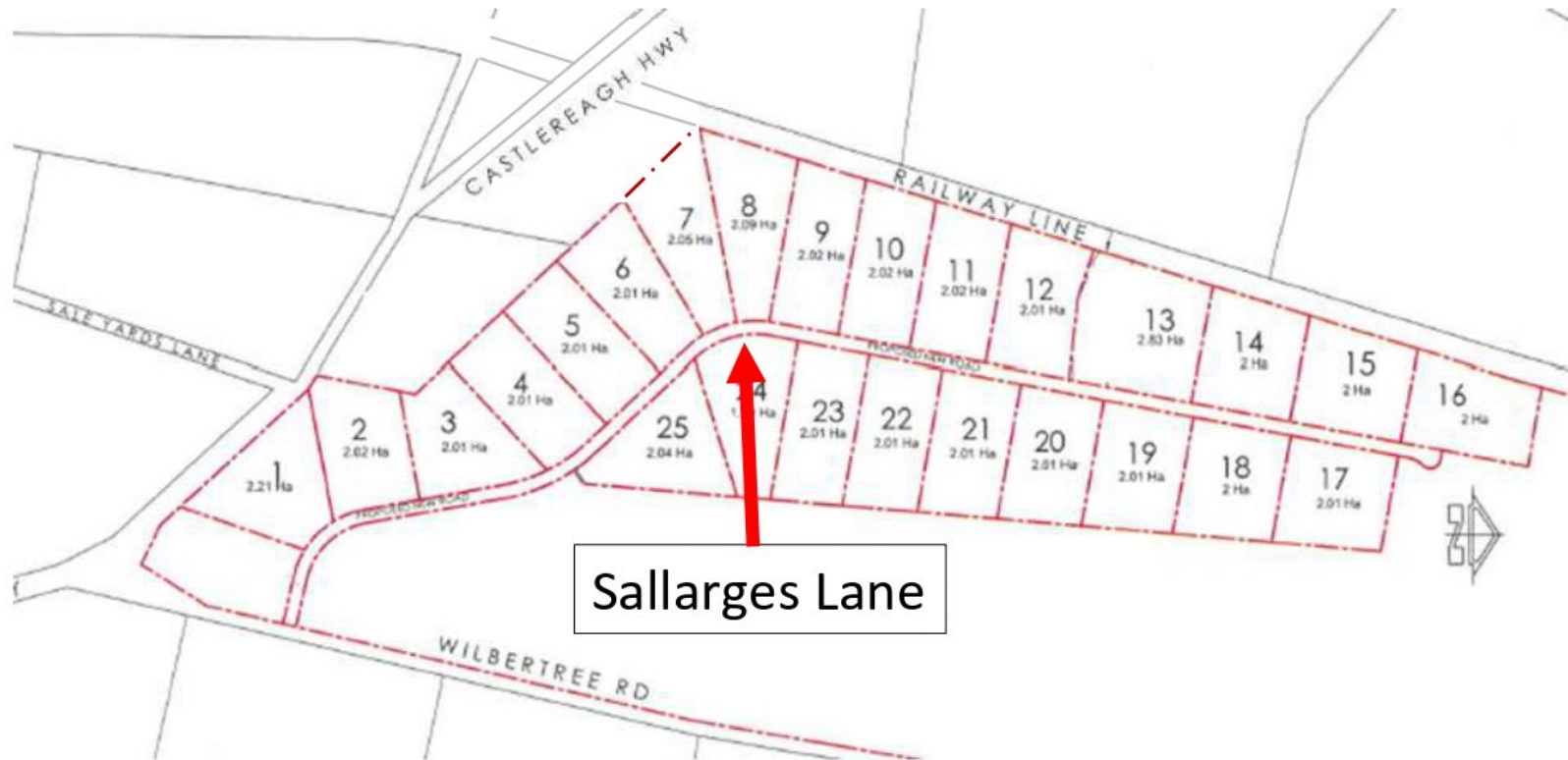
