



SITE MAP Appendix

Key

White rectangles – Powered sites – connect directly to a power point

Grey rectangles – Powered sites – connected to a distribution board attached to a 3-phase outlet

Unpowered sites – written on map as “unpowered” or “unpowered/generator” (230 sites) plus both big car parks could host unpowered camp sites

Site dimensions – each rectangle is at least 6x12m or 72m² (“A short-term site must have an area of at least 65 square metres” *Local Government (Manufactured Home Estates, Caravan Parks, Camping Grounds and Moveable Dwellings) Regulation 2021*)

T – blue “T” indicates a toilet block

S – showers

W (red) = water/tap outlet, therefore 2W = 2 water outlets

P (blue) = 15amp power point, therefore 4P on that power box/pole

3-phase = 3-phase power outlet on that power box/pole

E – Electrical Substation

Dump Points – 2 x written on map in blue “DUMP POINT” for disposal of grey and black water

Other square/rectangles are small sheds used for various storage or event purposes.

Car Parks – In Ring Rd/Pavilion/infrastructure area, car parks are shown in blue writing. When site isn’t utilised by camping, grass blocks can also be used as car parks. There are also 2 main car parks (paddocks) for large events – Henry Lawson Drive and Ulan Rd.

Accessible car parks – shown on Site Map in blue writing opposite small pavilion entrance. Depending on where the individual event is located, the hirer may wish to designate another area for accessible parking closer to the event area.

Site Access points

Gate 1 – Double gate at Mens Shed entrance

Gate 2 – 2 x double gates at roundabout at 267 Ulan Rd entrance

Gate 3 – 2 x double gates at “Ulan Rd car park” entrance

HLD 1 – Double gates directly off Henry Lawson Drive

HLD 2 – Double gates off Council laneway beside “HLD car park” entrance
