

Rural Waste Transfer Stations

Rural Waste Transfer Stations are only available to rural residents who live outside collection areas. These sites are for the disposal of domestic waste and recycling. Correct use of these facilities reduces the amount of waste sent to landfill.

ACCEPTED





General waste

All household garbage including non-recyclable packaging, food, disposable nappies, broken glass and ceramics, waxed cardboard, or broken glass or crockery.



Recycling

Paper, cardboard, glass bottles and jars, plastic bottles and containers, steel and aluminium cans.



Scrap metal*
(*not accepted at all facilities)

Iron, steel, fencing wire. Place in signposted area.

Green waste

Garden organics including lawn clippings and branches.



Bulky waste

Furniture such as mattresses, lounges and wardrobes.



Commercial waste

Please contact Council to discuss options for disposing of commercial waste.



Hazardous waste and liquid waste

Fluorescent lights, paint, oil, batteries, gas bottles and asbestos materials, cooking oil.



If it doesn't belong in a household bin, it doesn't belong at a Waste Transfer Station.

DID YOU KNOW?

You can dispose of residential green waste and furniture free of charge at Mudgee, Gulgong and Kandos Waste Facilities (see below). Please contact Council for disposal of domestic quantities of hazardous waste, including asbestos (under 10m²) and household chemicals.

GETTING THE MOST OUT OF YOUR TRANSFER STATION

On arrival to the Waste Transfer Stations, please read all signage and deposit appropriate waste only. Waste Facilities and Waste Transfer Stations are continuously monitored by Council using CCTV.

All waste must be deposited in bins provided and recyclables must only be deposited in the recyclable area*.

Green waste and bulky goods (including furniture) are to be taken to Mudgee, Gulgong or Kandos Waste Facilities for free disposal.







Some sites may accept scrap steel placed in the signed scrap metal stockpile area.

SAVE TIME, SORT YOUR WASTE



Save yourself valuable time by sorting waste prior to leaving home, and simplify your drop off at the Waste Transfer Station.



Throwing everything into the trailer or ute makes it harder to separate, contaminating materials that could have otherwise been recycled.



Secure your load to prevent roadside littering. Driving with an unsecured load is an offence against the Roads Act (1986).
